

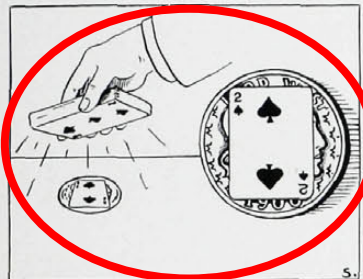

JACK GWYNNE RABBIT BOX

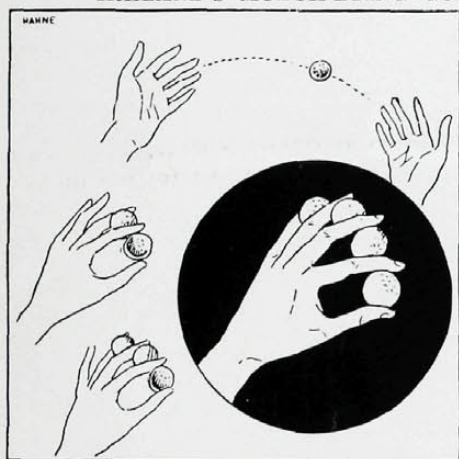

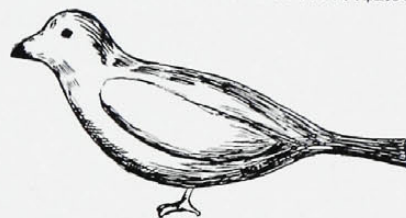

CONTROLLED COINCIDENCE

Two cards chosen by two spectators. First party slips a knife into pack. Magician separates pack at this place. Party now shows the card he is holding, say Ten of Hearts, and on examining pack, which has been broken by knife, he finds the bottom card of top packet is ten—whilest the top card of the bottom packet is a heart. Cards now run out on table, backs up—one card is reversed—and on second party removing reversed card and one above it—one is a Jack and other a club. Again designating the second chosen card.
